## Course outline

The HND in Equine Management will offer students a thorough grounding in the key concepts, management issues and practical skills required in the equine industry.

## Entry requirements

You will need either:

- a National Diploma in Horse Management, or
- a GCE Advanced Level, or
- BHS Stage II, or
- work related experience

## Course content

You will study the following units:

- investigative project
- biological principles
- horse husbandry
- animal health and welfare
- land use issues and policies
- environmental management

Specialist units:

- land based industry experience
- anatomy and physiology
- management of the performance horse
- teaching and instruction
- event management
- equitation
- further equitation

- advanced equitation – competing and training
- advanced equitation – training and instruction

The HND will lead students into employment or onto further study on degree or professional courses.

The course is designed to provide a specialist vocational programme with strong work related emphasis. Career opportunities include positions in management, professional rider/teacher, research.
