



## HNC/D in Equine Management

### Course outline

The HNC/D in Equine Management will offer students a thorough grounding in the key concepts, management issues and practical skills required in the equine industry.

### Entry requirements

You will need either a National Diploma in Horse Management, a GCE Advanced Level, BHS Stage II or work related experience.

### Course content

HNC core modules include business environment, research project, biological principles and horse husbandry. HNC specialist units include anatomy and physiology, management of the performance horse, riding on the flat and research methods.

HND core modules include business environment, research project, biological principles, horse husbandry, animal health and welfare. HND specialist units include event management, equitation training and instruction, equine exercise physiology and riding horses over fences.

### Assessment methods

Assessment methods include, academic assignments, practical assessments, time constrained assignments, seminars and student lead discussions.

### Progression opportunities

Students could gain employment or progress to study on degree or professional courses.

### Career opportunities

The course provides a specialist vocational programme with strong work related emphasis. Career opportunities include positions in management, research or as a professional rider/teacher.
