## Travel and tourism courses

### Level 1 - Introductory Diploma in Travel and Tourism

**Code** TSM0010F **Location** Ashington

**Ideal if...** you are interested in a career in the travel and tourism industry, but have few formal qualifications.

#### Entry requirements



You should have two GCSEs at grade F and an interest in travel and tourism.

### Level 2 - Diploma in Travel and Tourism

**Code** TSM0037F **Location** Ashington, Berwick

**Ideal if...** you are interested in a career in the travel and tourism industry. This course gives a general overview of all aspects of travel and tourism.

#### Entry requirements



You should have two GCSEs at grade C or above, or a relevant level 1 qualification, plus basic skills in communication and numeracy.

## Level 2 - Aviation

**Code** TSM0022P / TSM0023P **Location** Ashington, Berwick

**Ideal if...** you are interested in developing skills for a career as airline cabin crew or a passenger service agent. You will study units including aviation, health and safety and airport security and communications.

### Entry requirements



You should have two GCSEs at grade C or a relevant level 2 qualification.

## Level 2 - Resort Representatives

**Code** TSM0001P **Location** Ashington

**Ideal if...** you are interested in developing skills for a career as a holiday representative. You will study units including responsible tourism and resort representation.

### Entry requirements



You should have two GCSEs at grade C or above, or a relevant level 2 qualification.

## Level 2 - Apprenticeship Travel and Tourism

**Code** TSM0048P **Location** Ashington

**Ideal if...** you work in the travel and tourism industry and want to develop your skills and gain a qualification.

### Entry requirements



You should have two GCSEs at grade D or above, including English and maths, or a relevant level 1 qualification and be employed in the industry.

## Level 3 - Diploma in Travel and Tourism

**Code** TSM0013F **Location** Ashington

**Ideal if...** you are interested in training for initial employment in a travel and tourism role or progression to higher education. You will study units including researching UK, long haul and European destinations and the business of travel and tourism and retail services.

### Entry requirements



You should have five GCSEs at grade C or above, or a relevant level 2 qualification.

## Level 3 - Advanced Apprenticeship Travel and Tourism

**Code** TBC **Location** Ashington

**Ideal if...** you work in the travel and tourism industry and want to develop your skills and gain a higher level qualification.

### Entry requirements



You should have four GCSEs at grade C or above, including English and maths, or a relevant level 2 qualification and be employed in the industry.

## Additional qualifications
