If you have an interest in the preservation of a sustainable environment, the countryside and natural habitats, you will find a career in this industry rewarding.

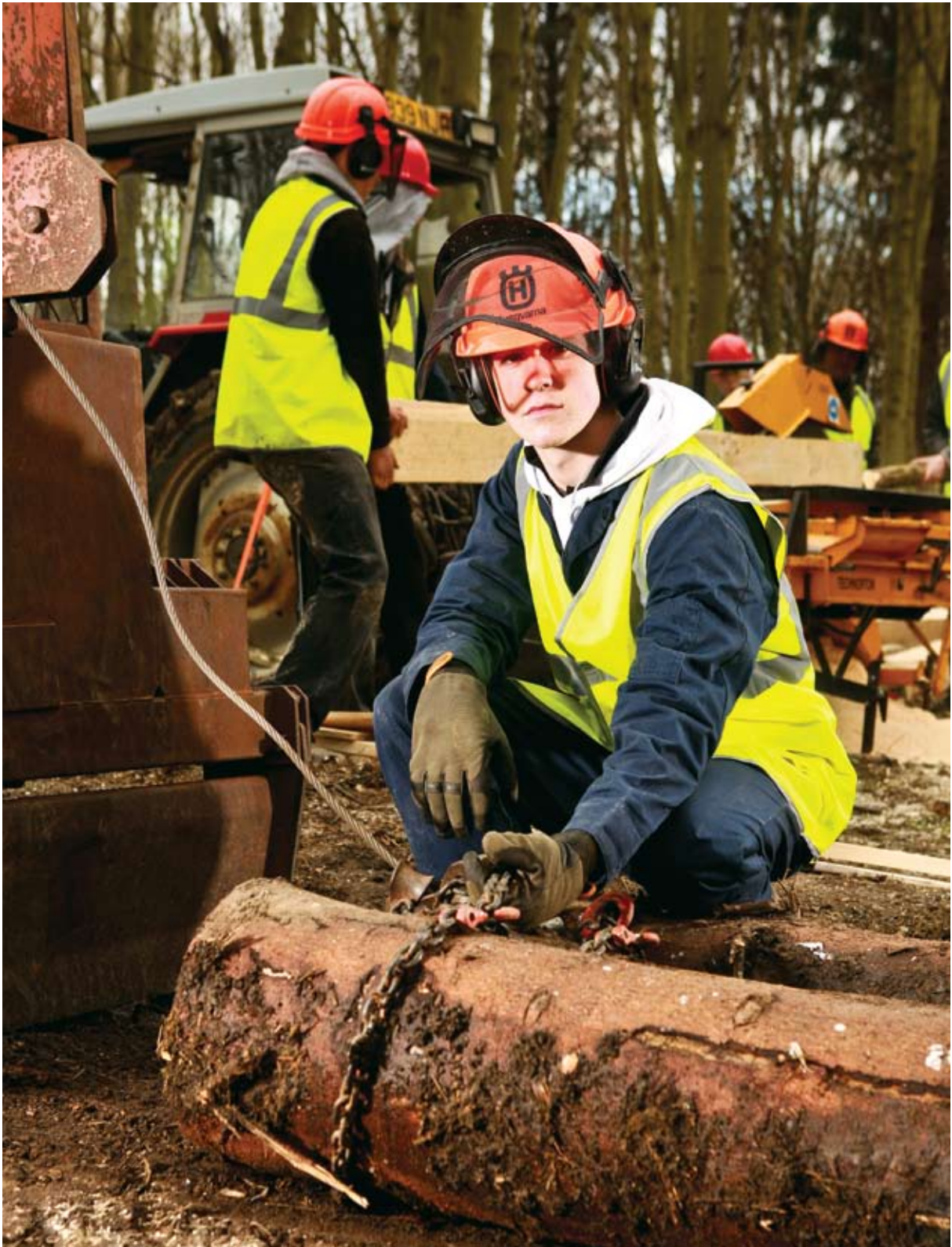
